# MATCH INFORMATION

Republic of Ireland vs Grenada

Saturday, 16 May 2026

Kick-off: 18:00 local time CET  
(17:00 Irish time GMT)

The match will take place at the [Estadio Enrique Roca de Murcia](#), also locally known as Estadio Nueva Condomina.

Please note that many local transport signs and directions may still refer to the stadium as “Estadio Nueva Condomina”. Both names refer to the same stadium.

The stadium is located in the district of Churra, approximately 7 kilometres north of Murcia city centre.

# ESTADIO ENRIQUE ROCA DE MURCIA

We are delighted to welcome all football supporters to the Estadio Enrique Roca de Murcia for the international fixture between the Republic of Ireland national football team and the Grenada national football team on 16 May at 18:00H.

Opened in 2006, the stadium was officially inaugurated on 11 October 2006 with an international friendly match between Spain and Argentina. Originally known as Estadio Nueva Condomina, the venue now goes by the name Estadio Enrique Roca de Murcia.

With a capacity of more than 31,000 spectators, it is the largest stadium in the Region of Murcia and the home ground of Real Murcia CF.

We wish all travelling fans a fantastic and unforgettable match-day experience in Murcia.





# TRAVEL TO MURCIA

We expect most travelling supporters to arrive via:

- Alicante–Elche Miguel Hernández Airport (ALC)
- Región de Murcia International Airport (RMU)

Both airports are well connected to Murcia city by public transport, taxis, and private transfers.

## **Bus Services**

Long-distance buses between airports and Murcia operate regularly throughout the day.

## **Taxi & Ride-Hailing**

Taxi services and ride-hailing apps such as Uber and Bolt are widely available throughout Murcia and Alicante.

## **By Car**

There will be ample parking available at the stadium on matchday, and parking is free of charge for supporters.



# GETTING TO THE STADIUM

The stadium is well connected to Murcia city centre by tram.

## **Tram**

The tram stop for the stadium is:

Frequent tram services will operate throughout matchday before and after kick-off.

## **Important Supporters Information**

Republic of Ireland supporters should follow the official signage directing fans towards the visiting supporters entrance area – Tribuna Lateral.

Supporters arriving by tram should look out for directional signage immediately upon exiting the Estadio Nueva Condomina tram stop.

Additional signage will also be placed on the pedestrian bridge connecting the commercial centre (Centro Comercial Nueva Condomina), and the stadium.

Please allow additional time close to kick-off due to increased foot traffic around the stadium.



# STADIUM ENTRY

Supporters are encouraged to arrive early to avoid delays at security checks and stadium entrances.

Tickets may be presented either digitally on a mobile device or in printed format.

Fans may be searched by local police or stadium security before entering the stadium.

## **Important Information**

- We are not currently expecting ID checks; however, supporters are advised to keep a scan or photo of their passport on their phone.
- Bags larger than A4 size will not be permitted inside the stadium.
- Please follow all steward and police instructions at all times.
- There is currently no planned holdback after the match. If this changes, updates will be communicated through the SLO WhatsApp channel, the [Ireland SLO X Account](#), and stadium announcements in English.



# FAN FACILITIES

A variety of food and non-alcoholic beverages will be available inside the stadium on matchday.

Please note that alcohol will **NOT** be sold inside the stadium.

Located directly beside the stadium is the [Centro Comercial Nueva Condomina](#), one of the largest shopping and leisure centres in the Region of Murcia.

Supporters can use the commercial centre before and after the match for shopping, restaurants, cafés, supermarkets, pharmacies, and other necessities. The centre includes a wide range of stores and dining options for travelling fans.
