MATCH INFORMATION

Canada v Republic of Ireland

Friday, 5 June 2026

Kick-off: 19:30 local time

(00:30 Irish time BST (Saturday))

The match will take place at the [Stade Saputo](#), also locally known as Saputo Stadium.

The stadium is located in the Olympic Park area. The address is 750 Pierre-de-Coubertin Ave, Montreal, QC approximately 6 kilometres northeast of downtown Montreal.

Match Tickets

Match tickets are sold out. Visiting fans who purchased tickets will receive them electronically.

Please share this guide with any friends or family travelling to the match. We have done our best to ensure all information is accurate at the time of publication; however, details may be subject to change.

Stade Saputo

Opened in 2008, the stadium is the home of CF Montreal. It is a football specific stadium in the Olympic Park area. The area was originally developed for the 1976 Olympics.

It has a capacity of more than 19,000 spectators.

TRAVEL TO Montreal

We expect most travelling supporters to arrive via:

- Montreal Trudeau Airport (also known as Dorval) (YUL)

The airport is well connected to downtown by public transport, taxis, and private transfers.

Bus Services

The 747 express bus connects the airport with downtown at a cost of approx. CAD\$12. Buy at the kiosks in arrivals or use the [app](#)

Taxi & Ride-Hailing

Taxi services and ride-hailing apps such as Uber are widely available throughout Quebec



GETTING TO THE STADIUM

The stadium is well connected to downtown by metro.

Metro

The metro stations for the stadium are:

Viau and Pie-IX on the green line

Frequent metro services will operate throughout matchday before and after kick-off.

Important Supporters Information

Republic of Ireland supporters should follow the official signage directing fans towards the visiting supporters entrance area in the southeast corner.

Please allow additional time close to kick-off due to increased foot traffic around the stadium.



STADIUM ENTRY

Supporters are encouraged to arrive early to avoid delays at security checks and stadium entrances.

Tickets may be presented either digitally on a mobile device or in printed format.

Fans may be searched by local police or stadium security before entering the stadium.

Important Information

- We are not currently expecting ID checks; however, supporters are advised to keep a scan or photo of their passport on their phone.
- Bags larger than 14" x 14" x 6" are not allowed. Bag storage is available outside for a fee.
- Please follow all steward and police instructions at all times.
- There is currently no planned holdback after the match. If this changes, updates will be communicated through the SLO WhatsApp channel, the [Ireland SLO X Account](#), and stadium announcements in English.



FAN FACILITIES

A wide variety of food, alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages will be available inside the stadium on matchday.

We expect fanzones, family friendly areas and in general the matchday experience in Canada is very welcoming.

Please note the stadium is cashless



SAFETY INFORMATION

Montreal is generally considered a safe and welcoming city for travelling supporters. As with any major sporting event, supporters are advised to remain aware of their belongings in crowded areas.
