

SPAR FAI Primary School 5s 2022

Programme Terms & Conditions

 - f) how many students are enrolled in 4/5/6th class in the school as of 30th September 2021,
 - g) contact details (name, phone number & email address)
- 6) Special schools are asked to contact footballforall@fai.ie before registering.
 - a) Any additional support required and support available from the FAI will be evaluated before registration of a special school is accepted.
- 7) The FAI reserves the right to cancel any registration and expel any participants from the programme as it deems appropriate.
