

SPAR FAI School Zone Teachers Competition

Prize draw Terms & Conditions

The promoters are SPAR Ireland and FAI Schools.

1. SPAR Ireland and the Football Association of Ireland are joint sponsors of the promotion and hold joint responsibility for promotion management.
2. The prize draw is open to teachers of schools in the Republic of Ireland only, aged 18 years or older.
3. Employees of SPAR Ireland, the FAI, their families, agents or anyone else connected with this promotion are excluded from this competition.
4. No purchase is necessary. Entry to the prize draw is free.
5. Only one entry per class. A teacher who registers for different class groups will receive one entry for each class registered. Multiple entries made by the same person from various email accounts or from the same IP address will not be accepted.
6. To enter simply register to receive lesson plans by email from FAI Schools. Teachers must register at <https://www.fai.ie/domestic/spar-fai-school-zone/register>
7. To qualify, teachers must register between Monday 8th March 2021 and Wednesday April 21st 2021. Teachers must register on behalf of students in 4th, 5th or 6th class. No exemptions will be given.
8. 26 x county prizes offered consist of: 8 x jerseys, 8 x shorts, 8 x socks.
9. 1 x grand prize offered consists of: a zoom call with 3 players from the Republic of Ireland Senior Men's Team. This call will take place during June 2021 and a time and date will be agreed with the winning teacher.
10. The prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative.
11. At the end of the competition, 1 winner per county will be chosen at random from the entries. There will be 26 winners in total; each winner will receive a football kit for their class. The winners will be selected on Friday 23rd April 2021.

12. Kit sizes and colours will be determined by the Football Association of Ireland and their supplier. Sizes and colours cannot be changed once distributed.
13. At the end of the competition, 1 winner will be chosen at random from all the entries. The winner will win the grand prize – a zoom call with 3 players from the Republic of Ireland Senior Men’s Team. The winner will be selected on Friday 23rd April 2021.
14. The personal information entrants provide will be used by the Promoter for the purpose of conducting this promotion and for no other purpose. The winners contact details will be shared between FAI Schools and SPAR Ireland in order to send out prizes. Once all parties are satisfied that you have received your prize, your contact details will be removed from all databases. The Promoter is bound by the Data Protection Act 1998 or General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) as applicable.

16. In the event that a winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within 7 days to winner notification, an alternative winner will be selected from the entries.

19. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility for lost, misplaced or damaged entries, nor any liability for technical errors or communication failures in networks and/or internet access or for any other reason.
